- Choose a representative to bargain with your employer on your behalf;
- Act together with other employees for your benefit and protection;
- Choose not to engage in any of these protected activities.

WE WILL NOT breach our duty of fair representation to you by representing you in connection with your grievance arbitrarily or in bad faith by failing to disclose that your representative presented evidence that led to your discipline.

WE WILL NOT in any like or related manner restrain or coerce you in the exercise of your rights under Section 7 of the Act
